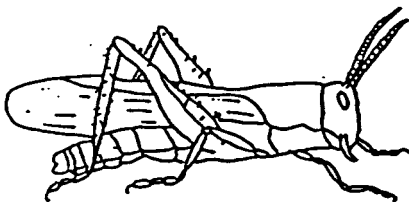

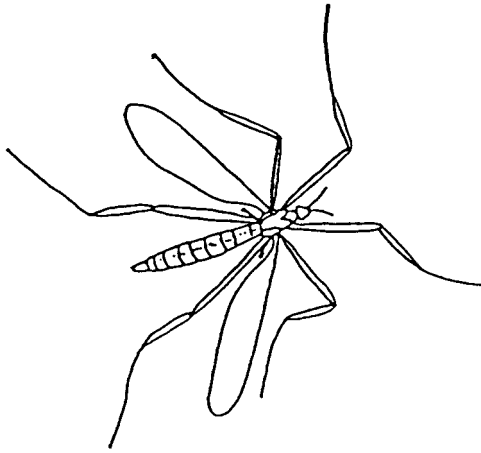

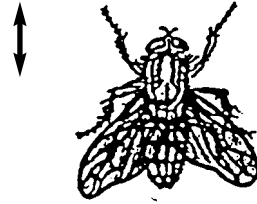

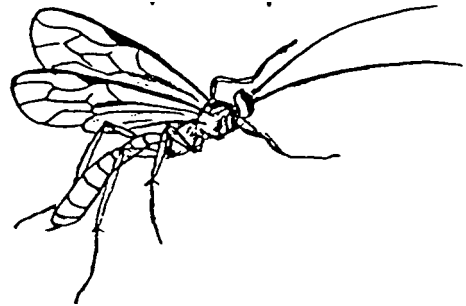

Crane Fly or Daddy-long-legs



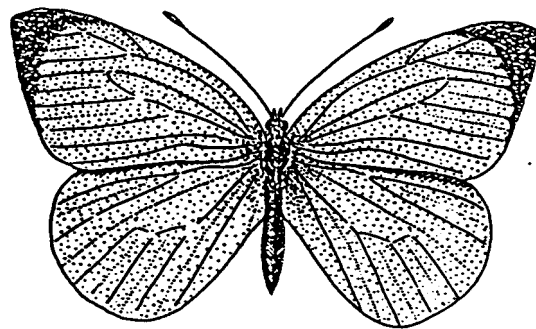
True Fly

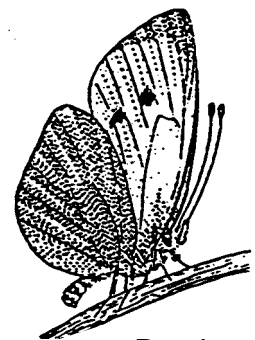

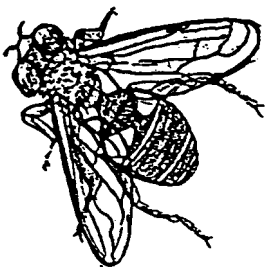
